


Figure 1: Sample flowchart depicting course homepage and preliminary set of pages in Web courses for TRE101




Figure 1a: Sample flowchart depicting pages for Module section of course




Figure 1b: Sample flowchart depicting pages for Discussion section of course




Figure 1c: Sample flowchart depicting pages for Assignment section of course




Figure 1d: Sample flowchart depicting pages for Course Material section of course



<p>Screen Layout:</p>  <p>HOW TO CHANGE A FLAT TIRE</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure you are parked on a flat surface and turn off the engine. Use your emergency breakers and parking brake. Remove the hubcap and loosen the lug nuts with the iron. Do not remove the lug nuts just yet. Consult the owners manual of the car to where to place the jack. It should be the sturdiest part of the car frame. Turn the jack until it makes contact with the underside of the car frame. Continue cranking until the tire is high enough off the ground to remove the flat. Do not let any part of your body get under the car while it is on the jack. Now you can finish removing the lug nuts, keeping them secure in the hub cap. Place the spare tire onto the wheel and replace the lug nuts. Make sure they are on as tight as possible. Lower the jack and finish tightening the lug nuts to the illustrated star pattern. 4 Bolt, 5 Bolt, 6 Bolt. Drive slowly on your emergency breakers as long as possible. 
