

Aneta Wlodyka (pronounced *Vlo-dé-ka*) is a Polish-born visual artist known for her dynamic and evolving body of work in painting and mixed media. She earned her Master of Fine Arts in studio painting from the University of Fine Arts Poznań in 1992.
