Artist's Bio

As a mixed media artist, Pat Strittmatter Jacunski-Barker, is interested in producing an atmosphere for people to experience inspiration, healing and passionate reflection through the beauty and freedom found in 'worship art'. Her intent is to create with a purpose beyond simply beautifying a space. "God is a creative God. Made in His image, we are each created to create."

After attending Indiana University of Pennsylvania and majoring in Art Education with a concentration in Fine Arts and various classes at Arrowmont School for the Arts in Gatlinburg, Pat went on as an art educator. Focused on each person being created to create she gave the hope that: "each person has to allow them self time to 'learn a skill' and practice it before their talent can be seen. Some people can learn a skill on their own and practice it and then flourish. Others are more comfortable taking classes. We aren't born able play piano or guitar at a professional level. Learning the skills of playing the instrument has to take place first. It is the same with visual arts. Many people feel they have no talent to create but don't give themselves the time to learn and practice an area of art until their talent is revealed."

Pat taught art at Cincinnati Hills Christian Academy in Ohio. With a move to Kentucky she taught at both Monart School of Drawing and Heritage Christian Academy. After retiring from teaching she opened her own gallery/studio in Covington Arts district in Kentucky to delve into her own time of practicing and developing a greater talent in visual arts.
