- 2009 *ab[landmass].* A typographic representation of change over time. Edition of ten.
- 2009 *1:50,000.* Produced during a residency at *Cló Ceardlann na gCnoc* in Donegal, Ireland. Printed from carbon paper. Edition of ten.
- 2009 *7/25/09.* Produced during a residency at *Cló Ceardlann na gCnoc* in Donegal, Ireland. Landscape embossed on an etching press. Edition of ten.
- 2008 *Point of View.* An exploration of one moment and location, one position in space and time. This book incorporates the structural device of the dissection plate into a representation of one person's relationship to their immediate surroundings. Edition of 100.
- 2007 *Cutaway.* This book features layered cross-section imagery printed on translucent material, removable cards printed with color, and reference language that that is mixed and shifted throughout the book. Edition of 45.
- 2006 *The Index.* A full-sized skeleton housed in clamshell box. This book can be viewed traditionally inside its box or unfolded to its full height to reveal the text, a complete index of the female anatomy. Edition of 45.
- 2006 *Fears: A Chronology.* An autobiographical book. Edition of 70.

#### CREATIVE PUBLICATIONS WITH SHIFT-LAB

- 2017 *Split Case.* Produced during a residency at the Hamilton Wood Type and Printing Museum. Printed from wood type in ink mixed to match colors found in the museum. Edition of 25.
- 2016 *Trace.* Explores the technology and aesthetics of mapping while responding to the traces of human activity left on the landscape. Individually, each artist investigated an arsenal, a quarry, a marina, a walking path, and a ski resort. Sensory experiences navigating a landscape in real time are reinterpreted through symbols, sequences, and sounds in an exhibition. Edition of 30.
- 2014 *[incode].* This project, a series of printing events, utilized social media, letterpress, and text-based communication (tweets) from the book art and print communities. It took place during two national conferences at The University of Utah in Salt Lake City in January, 2014 and San Francisco Center for the Book in March, 2014. A was published by the artists to documents these events. Zine edition of 100.
- 2013 *Shift.* Shift-lab's inaugural project as a collaborative group. Each artist created a book of identical dimensions with the theme of "shift," a word that plays a fundamental part of process and practice for artists and printmakers. Content ranges from an investigation of the diggings of the Erie canal, images of a shifting body during sleep, the translation of glyphs and grid systems, two perspectives in a conversation, and the physical shift in a page. Edition of 30.
